Twinsburg



The largest annual gathering of twins in the world.

In 1817, identical twins Aaron and Moses Wilcox purchased a plot of land in Ohio not far from Akron. They settled there, donated 20 \$ for the new school and six acres for a public square. The town was named Twinsburg in their honor.

The twins festival opened its doors for the first time 1976 with 37 pairs of twins. Over the course of the years the attendance has increased to thousands of twins, triplets, quadruplets and more, arriving each August to participate in the parade, various contests, twins talent show, share experiences, stories and so much more!

Each year a pair of Kings, Queens, Princes, and Princesses are selected for the festival to ride in a special vehicle near the front of the parade and sit at the review stand at the end of the parade.

MARY ELLEN MARK

I've always been fascinated by twins. In my forty years of photographing, whenever there was an opportunity I would take a picture of twins. I found the notion that two people could appear to look exactly alike very compelling.

I am both a documentary photographer and a portrait photographer. Great documentary photography captures a precise moment in one frame. Great portrait photography captures the essence of the person or persons being photographed. In portraiture, the subject is usually very aware of the camera. Sometimes a photograph is both portraiture and documentary.

Five years ago, I started working with the Polaroid 20x24 camera. I use this camera most often as a portrait camera. For me, there is no better format than 20x24 to catch that very essence of a person. The extraordinary detail in this format brings portraiture to yet another level. Of course because of the size and amount of light needed with this camera, the subject is most certainly aware when he or she is being photographed.

I've always been fascinated by twins. In my forty years of photographing, whenever there was an opportunity I would take a picture of twins. I found the notion that two people could appear to look exactly alike very compelling.

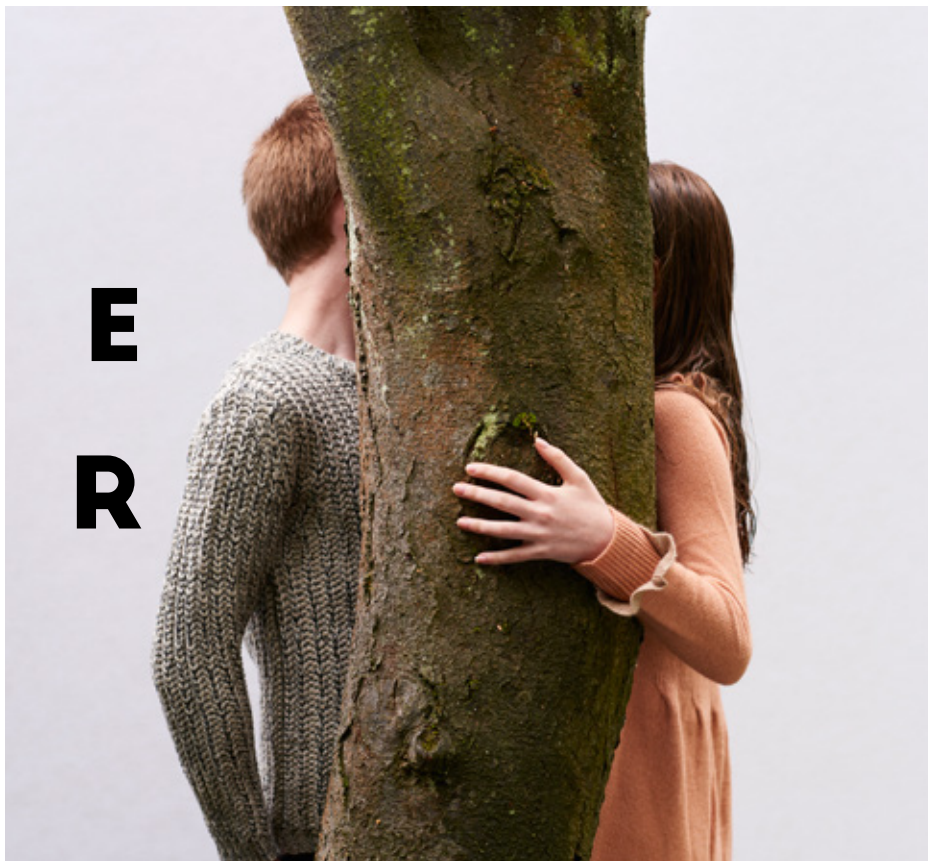
The Twins Days Festival in Twinsburg, Ohio is an annual gathering of several thousand sets of twins with festivities and events. I heard about it several years ago and I very much wanted to go there to take pictures. My first trip to Twinsburg was in 1998. It was an amazingly visual experience and at the same time, very strange and frustrating. It was like I was seeing double and I felt somewhat isolated not being a twin. At the airport on my way back to New York, I remember thinking how bizarre it was to be surrounded by non-twins [--]

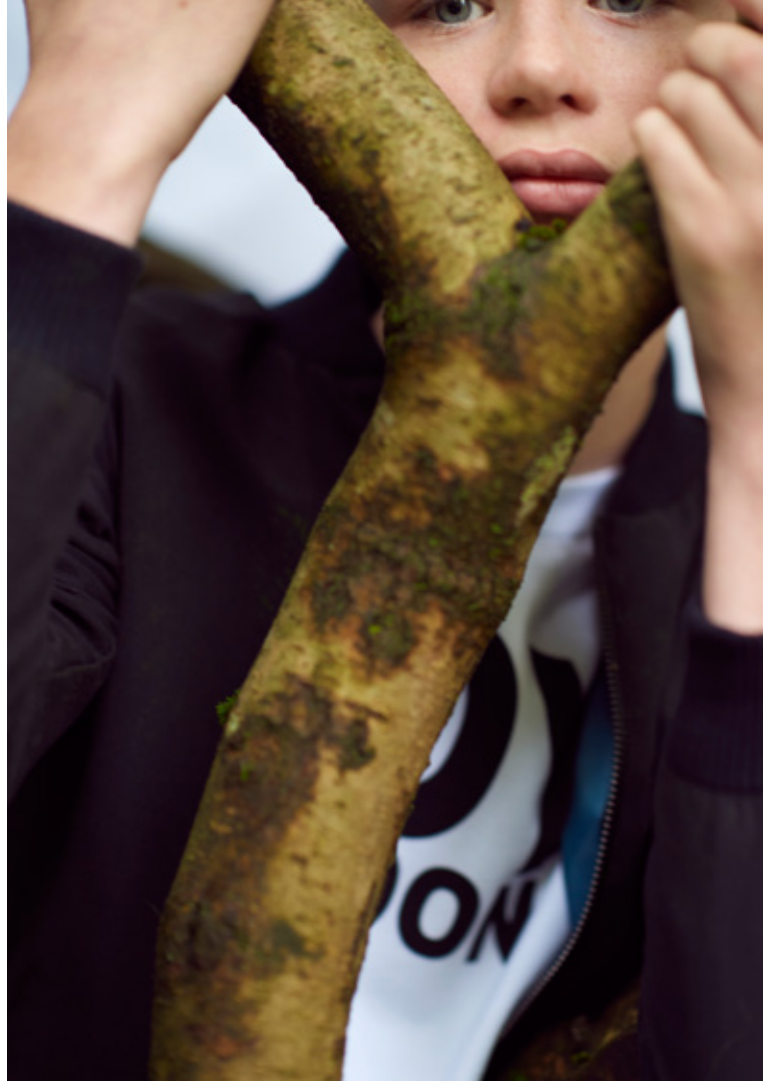

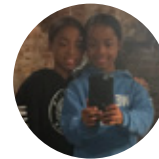

DOUG AND MIKE STARN

The Starns have received many honors including two National Endowment for the Arts Grants in 1987 and 1995; The International Center for Photography's Infinity Award for Fine Art Photography in 1992; and, artists in residency at NASA in the mid-nineties. They have received critical acclaim in

The New York Times, Dagens Nyheter, Corriere della Sera, Le Figaro, The Times (London), Art in America, and Artforum amongst many other notable media. Major artworks by the Starns are represented in public and private collections including: The Museum of Modern Art (NYC); San Francisco Museum



of Modern Art (SF); Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum, (NYC); The Jewish Museum, (NYC); The Metropolitan Museum of Art (NYC); Moderna Museet (Stockholm); The National Gallery of Victoria (Melbourne);

Whitney Museum of American Art (NYC); Yokohama Museum of Art (Japan); La Bibliothèque Nationale (Paris); La Maison Européenne de la Photographie (Paris); Los Angeles County

American artists, identical twins, born 1961. First having received international attention at the 1987 Whitney Biennial, for more than 20 years the Starns were primarily known for working with

photography, and are concerned largely with chaos, interconnection and interdependence. Over the past two and half decades, Doug and Mike Starn have a diverse conceptual practice that freely mixes photography, printmaking, sculpture, and architectural installation. Famous for their ongoing "Big Bambú" series (2008) - a massive, performative installation made from lashed together bamboo - they have intervened both on the roof of the Metropolitan Museum of Art and at the 54th Venice Biennale.

The brothers have also taken bamboo fragments from their installation and re-imagined them as freestanding sculpture. Their conceptual photography practice incorporates a variety of deconstructive techniques such as décollage, appropriation and reinterpretation of art historical work, and novel framing devices.

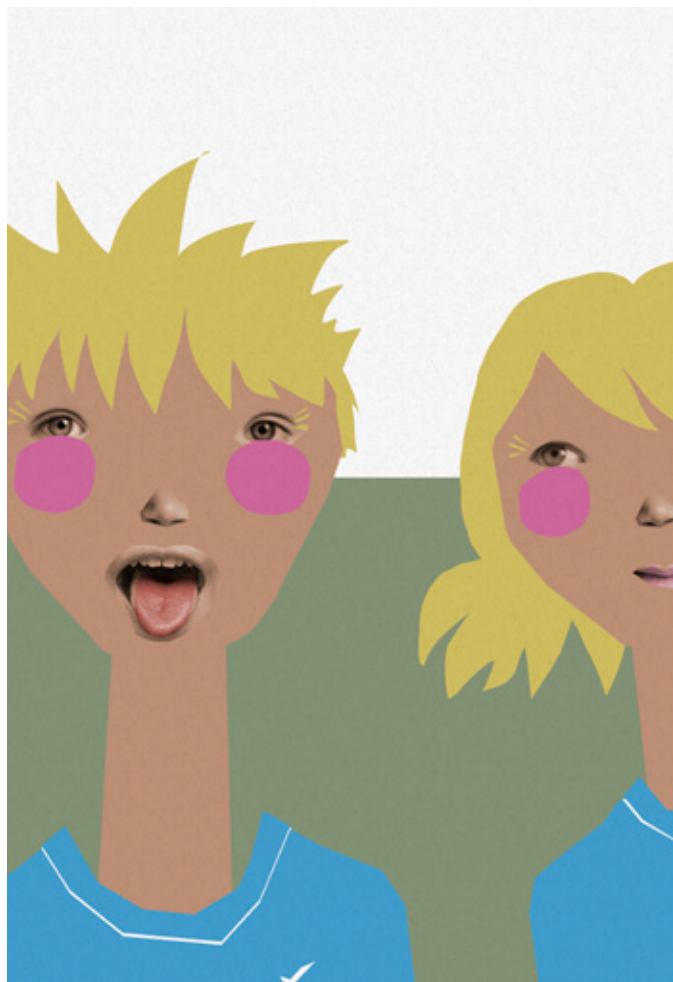

Maurice and Robin Gibbs

Maurice Gibb is most closely associated with the Bee Gees, the brother act that he co-founded with his siblings Barry Gibb, three years his senior, and Robin Gibb, a fraternal twin born two hours older than Maurice.

In contrast to Barry and Robin, who have shared and alternated the spotlight as lead vocalists, Maurice (pronounced "Morris" in British English) has been almost exclusively a backing vocalist for his four-decade career, providing a key part of the harmony singing for his brothers. In less overtly visible ways, however, he has been essential to the group's sound from the beginning of their recording career.

Robin Gibb was one of the most popular and most celebrated pop musicians of the '60s, '70s, and 80s. As a member of the Bee Gees, he sold over 100 million records worldwide during the course of a career in which he sang lead on many of their great pop hits, such as "Massachusetts," "I Gotta Get a Message to You," "I Started a Joke," "New York Mining Disaster 1941," and "How Can You Mend a Broken Heart."

While Gibb's falsetto became the Bee Gees' signature during the disco era, it was Robin's quietly passionate tenor that defined their first run of hits, and his harmony vocals with his brothers Barry and Maurice were always an integral part of their sound. Robin was also the first of the Bee Gees to pursue a solo career, and while he returned to the group after a brief breakup in the late '60s, he was in many respects the Bee Gee with the strongest identity.

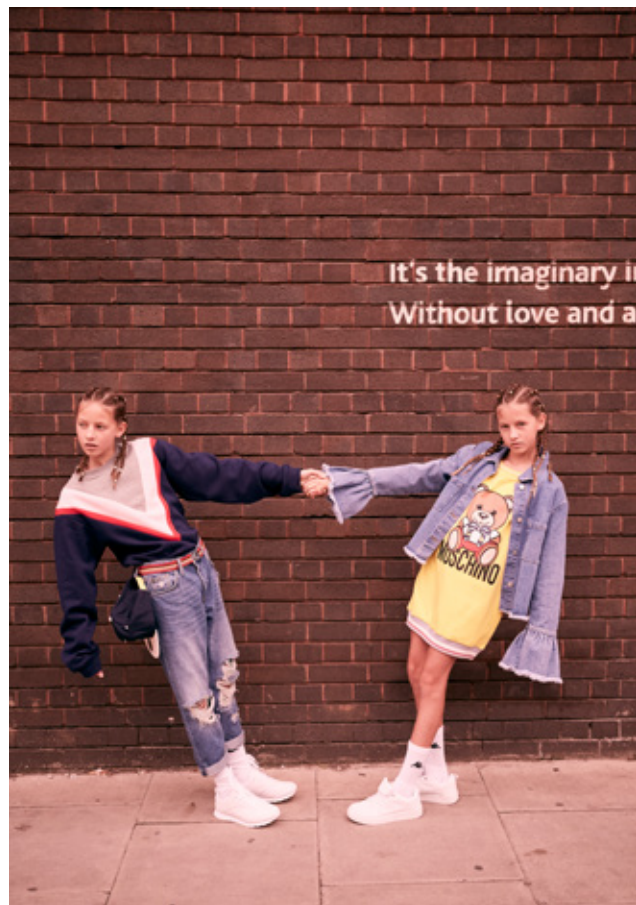
